**Free Training** provided in **Accessible Media by Mohawk College** delivered virtually and in class

Practical work experience in digital production provided by The Disability Channel in the areas of studio/video production, social media, digital editing and podcasting. Training locations in the regions of Peel, Halton and Hamilton.

Paid job placement assistance once successfully completed the **14 week program**
